The extent of digital adoption in the midstream sector will likely depend on companies' receptiveness to change—while some of them are realizing that even pipes, valves, etc., can be “smart,” the fact remains that only 50 percent consider existing data management as a high-priority item. Apart from the ever-extending reach of technology to address business issues, the falling cost of implementing digital technologies means that even small-to-mid-size midstream companies can access them competitively. However, a vast physical asset base and the mechanical operating culture have restricted companies from deploying high-end technologies on a large scale.
